1964	<i>unknown</i>	The US government stated that in 1964 they again minted peace silver dollars using the same design as in the early 1920's. However, these silver dollars were not released into the banking system. The U.S government says that all coins were melted. Because 1964 silver dollars were never released to the public, it is illegal to possess this date.							

*These values represent the 'average' market price at the time of this publication. Peace silver dollar over-dates exist during some years. Scarce varieties such as over-dates and errors were minted during some years and may be valued higher. Also, many factors can effect coin values, such as excessive bag marks, polishing, or damage. Lower priced coin prices may move when an ounce of spot silver changes in price, and if collector supply or demand changes. (Prices are in United States dollars.)

** During some years there were no peace silver dollars minted at all. In other years US PEACE Silver Dollars were minted at more than one government minting facility. Mint marks are as follows: no mint mark - US Philadelphia Mint; D mint mark - Denver Colorado mint; S mint mark- US San Francisco California government mint. Peace dollar mint marks are located on the dollars reverse near the eagle's tail.

*** Although the number of coins minted is known, the number still in existence today is much less. The "mintage column" above reflects the number of coins originally made. (Quantities minted come from many historical sources.) Throughout US history there have been several large silver dollar melts where the government destroyed silver dollars to remove the silver from the coins. No record was kept of the number or coin dates during these melts.

**** Coin grading is not a science, however it does use guidelines that many coin dealers follow. There are several degrees of Uncirculated or mint state in most grading systems. Uncirculated prices on this price guide are for typical mint condition silver dollars with normal amount of bag marks or surface blemishes for this type of coin. Higher grade uncirculated mint condition silverdollars will bring considerably higher prices.

In the year 1921 the United States government switched the silver dollar design from the "Morgan" style silverdollar to the "Peace" style silver dollar. This price guide begins with the second type of silver dollar minted in 1921, the Peace US Silver dollar. Weight is 26.7 grams. These silver dollar coins were made of 90% pure silver. The pure silver equivalent is approximately 77% of an oz. of pure silver.
